## HAVE A COLOR-THEMED PARTY

The Lifepius Foundation is associated with blue and gold so theming your party towards those colors keeps the cause top of mind and allows for a dose of creativity. Charge an entrance fee and include other ways to raise funds such as contests, auctions, or selling tickets for prize drawings. What's better than a good party for a great cause?



## HOLD A 5K RUN/WALK/CYCLE EVENT

This can be a low-cost with high return team fundraising event idea that's fun for all ages! Not only can you raise funds for your specific project, but you'll also organically raise awareness for the mission of the Lifepius Foundation through participants' sharing of your campaign with their network of friends and family.

Make sure the size and location of an event is reasonably manageable. Check with your local authorities for permission and that you meet all requirements. Then set a date and some realistic fundraising goals. To share the work, organize a committee and designate leaders to oversee the details. Themes add an extra element of fun!



## START A FUNDRAISING PAGE

You can start your own personal fundraising page that you can customize with pictures and information about your campaign. This way people can donate online directly towards your goal and they will receive an automatic receipt. This keeps you from having to deal with money directly. Showcase the talents of friends and local performance artists. In addition to an entry fee, supporters can donate to cast votes for winning numbers of different categories.
